



Rapid Recovery Provides Refrigerant Abatement at GE Nuclear Facility in San Jose, CA

Concord, California – July 8, 2005 – Rapid Recovery, a Contra Costa County based refrigerant abatement company, recently completed a project at the GE Nuclear Facility in San Jose, California, for Pacific States Environmental of Dublin, CA.

The project completed by Rapid Recovery in July, 2005, included 255 refrigerated appliance circuits throughout thirteen multi story buildings. Units were located on the ground, individual floors, and the roofs of various sized buildings. The a/c circuits contained various types and pounds of refrigerant. In all, seven different refrigerant types were recovered. Stickers were placed on each refrigerated appliance to show that the refrigerant had been properly recovered and documented.

Pacific States Environmental wasn't provided accurate information about the number and location of refrigerated units. It was requested that Rapid Recovery perform a "search and recover" type of service in which all buildings and surrounding areas were searched for refrigerated appliances and then recovered according to EPA guidelines.

In describing the services Rapid Recovery provided on this project Matt Jahn of Rapid Recovery said, "Since this facility covered almost sixty acres and included over a dozen buildings, our job was to search for and recover the refrigerant from chillers, split system, package a/c units, freezers and drinking fountains. We documented every unit and tracked every pound and type of refrigerant."

Pacific States Environmental was pleased with the amount of detail in the refrigerant documentation packet they received.
