



Rapid Recovery Removes Refrigerant from Former GM Assembly Plant in Baltimore, MD.

Phoenix, Arizona – March 31, 2006 – Rapid Recovery, an Arizona based refrigerant recovery company, recently completed a refrigerant recovery project encompassing more than 800 refrigerated appliances at the former GM Assembly Plant in Baltimore, Md. for MCM Management Corp. As part of their pre-demolition environmental efforts, MCM Management Corp. hired Rapid Recovery to perform the refrigerant abatement on hundreds of refrigerated appliances which had to be recovered prior to being dismantled and recycled.

Rapid Recovery was awarded the job on Friday March 10, 2006 and began work on the afternoon of March 15, 2006. The project consisted of recovering 20 transformers located throughout 6 separate roof top sub-stations, 8 separate chillers in 4 separate mechanical rooms, and over 700 other refrigerated appliances. MCM Management Corp. pulled and staged all of the small packaged refrigerated appliances in an effort to speed up the recovery process. This worked well and the job was completed on Friday March 24, 2006.

The plant covers over 3 ½ million square feet with 3 levels in some areas. This required several walking trips through all levels of the plant to insure that all refrigerant had been removed. Les Rhynard of Rapid Recovery said: “This is the type of project that you need a specialist to do. There was refrigerated equipment located here that wasn’t typical. The robot control panels had small a/c units attached, as well as some refrigeration equipment for the large stationary CO2 tanks which were inside metal housings.”

Rapid Recovery crews completed the work in just 9 days. All refrigerated appliances were recovered, documented, and tagged for identification. “We were able to move very quickly due to the efforts of the MCM team working quickly to stage the units for us. Every job is different, but it is very important on each to develop good working relationships with the other companies involved in the project. It was a pleasure to work with the MCM Management Corp. team.” said Rhynard.
