



## **Rapid Recovery Removes Refrigerant From Oldest Hospital in Butler County, OH**

Chicago, IL. March 1, 2007 – Rapid Recovery, a Chicago based refrigerant recovery company, recently completed a refrigerant recovery project at the 114 year old Mercy Hospital in Hamilton, Ohio.

The hospital, which originally opened in 1892 with fewer than twenty beds, was purchased by the Hamilton City Council in 2003.

Jim Arnett of J&L Management Corporation of Michigan phoned Rapid Recovery to abate the refrigerant in early January 2007. With the power already shut off and an unknown number of refrigerated appliances, Rapid Recovery walked the job thoroughly to ensure all refrigerated appliances were recovered. Paul Rhynard of Rapid Recovery said, “With the demolition start date approaching fast, we needed to get the job done quickly so that none of the other prep work would be held up. We went floor to floor to ensure we located and recovered all of the refrigerated appliances in the building.”

The hospital contained 62 refrigerated appliances total, including 4 chillers with 250 tons of cooling capacity each. Each chiller also operated on different refrigerant types. All of the refrigerated appliances were labeled with a “refrigerant recovered” sticker so that anyone can easily identify that the units have been recovered. “The orange stickers that we place on the units are numbered, have our technician’s name, and the date the unit was recovered. Units we have recovered on a jobsite are quickly identified by looking at the bright orange label that stands out even from a distance.” said Rhynard. J&L Management Corporation’s Matt Schwab said “Paul Rhynard and (John White) are both professional, knowledgeable refrigerant abatement experts. We look forward to working with Rapid Recovery on future projects.”
